MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS

Only devices meeting the minimum specifications provided by the College will be able to be connected to the College network. We have not specified a brand of device as this is parent/guardian choice however the device must have the following minimum specifications to enable the best educational outcomes and connection to the College network:

- Windows 10
- Minimum 8GB of RAM*
- Minimum Intel i3 (generation 6 or newer)
- Solid state hard (SSD) drive recommended but not essential *
- 5 GHz Wi-Fi & USB 3 port
- Long battery life
- Robust carry case
- Optional – touch screen with stylus

Please Note: 8GB RAM and a SSD are the two most significant and cost effective performance enhancers you can buy regardless of make or model.
