

The Education Department's policy on school dress empowers schools to make the wearing of uniform compulsory. The College has found that the wearing of uniform has brought many benefits such as the promotion of the College's public image, improved morale, team spirit and pride, reduced rivalry, convenience and it is relatively inexpensive. It ensures a higher standard of dress and it demonstrates to students that dress is appropriate to a given situation. Darling Range Sports College has a dress code policy determined in consultation with parents, students and staff.

All students must wear the College uniform every day. Unless otherwise stated, all students attending Darling Range Sports College excursions must comply with the uniform policy.

Enrolment at Darling Range Sports College assumes an agreement between the College, the parent/guardian and the enrolling student that the College uniform will be adhered to. Students who breach the uniform policy **will incur consequences**.

**All items of uniforms are to be purchased from the College uniform shop. No variations will be accepted.**

The Darling Range Sports College uniform consists of:

- Tops:** Middle School students wear navy blue polo shirts with the DRSC logo  
Senior School students wear white or navy blue polo shirts with DRSC logo
- Bottoms:** Navy blue skirts or shorts bearing the DRSC logo
- Tracksuit:** All students may wear the Darling Range Sports College tracksuit  
Tracksuit jacket and pants can be worn together or separately
- Jumper:** Navy blue fleece jacket with DRSC logo
- Footwear:** Must have low soles and be fully enclosed. Ugg boots are not acceptable
- Headwear:** Navy caps bearing the Darling Range logo  
Religious headwear must be plain navy or plain white only
- PE:** Physical Education T-shirt or singlet  
Black Physical Education training shorts with DRSC logo  
Sports shoes/joggers  
College tracksuit  
Approved College event shirts

## **PLEASE NOTE:**

- Girls may wear skin, navy or black tights/stockings only. Footless tights and leggings are not permitted
- Undershirts/sleeves to cover arms are to be skin, white or navy only, with no motifs or patterns
- Hats are encouraged for sun protection but they must be College hats only. Other hats are not permitted inside the College grounds (beanies, berets and bandanas are not part of the College dress code)
- Religious headwear must be either plain white or plain navy.
- You must bring a change of clothes for PE. You cannot wear PE clothes to your other classes
- AEROSOL CANS are not permitted. You must use roll on deodorant only

The College Administration or delegate has the right to determine whether an item of uniform is inappropriate due to a range of factors including but not exclusively:

- tightness of a skirt or t-shirt
- length of shorts and skirt
- degree of fading
- state of wear and tear

***Students who breach the uniform policy will incur consequences***
