

UNIFORM POLICY

The Education Department's policy on school dress empowers schools to make the wearing of uniform compulsory. The College has found that the wearing of uniform has brought many benefits such as the promotion of the College's public image, improved morale, team spirit and pride, reduced rivalry and convenience. It ensures a higher standard of dress and it demonstrates to students that dress is appropriate to a given situation. Darling Range Sports College has a dress code policy determined in consultation with parents, students, staff and the College Board.

All students must wear the College uniform every day. Unless otherwise stated, all students attending Darling Range Sports College excursions must comply with the uniform policy.

Enrolment at Darling Range Sports College assumes an agreement between the College, the parent/guardian and the enrolling student that the College uniform will be adhered to. Students who do not comply with the policy will be given the choice of:

- Borrowing an item of clothing from the College
- The Parent/Carer bringing in the correct uniform and changing on school site
- Returning home with parent permission to change into the correct uniform

Breaches to the uniform policy will be recorded and affect the student's Good Standing and may result in probation from academic and sporting programs.

The Darling Range Sports College uniform consists of:

Tops: Year 7-9 students wear navy blue polo shirts with the DRSC logo

Year 10-12 students wear white or navy blue polo shirts with DRSC logo

Bottoms: Navy shorts with the DRSC logo

Physical Education shorts can only be worn for sport classes

Tracksuit: All students may wear the DRSC tracksuit

Tracksuit jacket and pants can be worn together or separately

Jumper: Navy blue fleece jacket with DRSC logo

Hooded jumpers are not permitted

Footwear: Must have low soles and be fully enclosed. Ugg boots are not acceptable

Headwear: Navy caps bearing the Darling Range logo

Religious headwear must be plain navy or plain white only

Phys Ed: Physical Education T-shirt or singlet

Black Physical Education training shorts with DRSC logo

Sports shoes/joggers College tracksuit

Approved College event shirts

The Principal reserves the right to approve individual, plain navy blue items that do not have the College logo.
